B. FIRST ROUND INFORMATION:

1. **ALL TEAMS ARE TO PROVIDE A SCOREKEEPER, LIBERO TRACKER AND AN ADULT LINE JUDGE.**

2. Host schools are to provide scoreboard operators and ticket sellers.

3. Host schools are to provide 12 balls per court. Do not take balls outside the gym. Do not bring volleyballs to the tournament site.

4. All 1st round warm-up will be on the playing court. Teams will have 17 minutes to warm-up prior to first match. (5-6-6) All warm-ups after 1st round will be held in the designated warm-up gym. **THERE WILL BE NO "ON COURT" WARM-UP AFTER THE 1ST ROUND (Exception: #5 team in the 1st round will warm up in the designated warm up gym)**

5. All matches will be 2 out of 3 to 21 points and the deciding game to 15 points

DETERMINING SITE WINNERS:

1. Final won/loss record in matches

2. If record of two teams are tied use head to head competition

3. If there is a 3 way tie the winning % of all games will determine the 1, 2 & 3 seeds for a playoff. Seed #2 will play seed #3 one game to 21. The winner will play the #1 seed 1 game to 21 to determine places 1 & 2.

4. If winning % is tied -

A. each team flips a coin with the odd team determined to be the #3 seed.

B. remaining teams seeding is based on head to head competition to determine #1 & #2 seeds.

C. seed # 2 and #3 will play one game to 21

D. the winner between #2 and #3 will play one game to 21 with #1 seed

C. FINAL ROUND SITE AND TEAMS:

1. The top two teams in each pool will qualify for the championship round on Saturday, September 27, 2008 beginning at 5:00PM. The site of the finals will be at Southeastern Community College with the highest seeded team to serve as the host school in conjunction with SCC.
2. All matches will be 2 out of 3 to 25 points with the deciding match to 15 points
- 3. The host school will provide 2 libero trackers, 2 scorekeepers, game balls and ticket sellers.**
- 4. All schools in the final round are to provide one adult line judge.**
- 5. SCC will provide the scoreboard operator.**
